ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

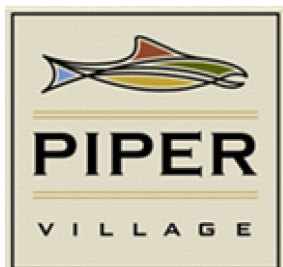
